



Ball State University - GPA Calculation

The grade-point average (GPA) is used to evaluate a student's academic record. Quality points are allocated to grades earned as follows:

A = 4.000	B+ = 3.333	C+ = 2.333	D+ = 1.333	F = 0.000
A- = 3.667	B = 3.000	C = 2.000	D = 1.000	
	B- = 2.667	C- = 1.667	D- = 0.667	

To calculate the GPA, divide the total number of credit points earned by the total number of credits attempted.

EXAMPLE:

Course	Grade	Quality Points		Credits Attempted	=	Credit Points
ENG 103	B+	3.333	x	3	=	9.999
MATHS 125	B	3.000	x	3	=	9.000
HIST 150	C+	2.333	x	3	=	6.999
PEFWL 103	A-	3.667	x	2	=	7.334
ASTRO 100	A	4.000	x	3	=	12.000
				<u>14</u>		<u>45.332</u>

Total Credit Points (45.332) divided by Total Credits Attempted (14) = 3.238 GPA
