Discussion:

- A. Introductions- Committee members introduced themselves.
- B. Committee Reports- The draft committee reports were discussed. The reports for the Parks and Open Space Committee and the Public Safety and Code Enforcement Committee have been distributed to their committees for review. The other three will be distributed to their committees soon.
- C. Irvington Neighborhood Survey- The Irvington Neighborhood Survey-Tabulation and Analysis was discussed. It was suggested that it be an appendix to the final report.
- D. Ranking the Projects and Programs- The following three options for ranking the projects and programs were discussed:
 - Each committee ranks their own projects and programs,
 - The projects and programs are combined and ranked by the community at a town hall meeting, and
 - The projects and programs are combined in a survey that is distributed to the community for ranking before the Community Visioning Activity.

The Steering Committee chose the ranking by community survey option. Staff will prepare a draft of the ranking survey.

- E. Timeline- The project timeline was discussed. It was decided that the next step will be to prepare and distribute the projects and programs ranking survey. At the same time, staff will begin to assemble the committee reports into a combined draft document. There will be a Steering Committee meeting in October so that staff can report progress with the ranking survey and preparation of the draft report.
