

JEFF LINDSEY DIRECTOR, REGULATORY POLICY

Jeff Lindsey currently serves as Director, Regulatory Policy for Embarq. He is responsible for managing such regulatory policy matters as intercarrier compensation, universal service, lessening the regulatory burden and reducing competitive regulatory disparities on Embarq at federal and state levels.

Prior to his current assignment, Jeff served as Director, Federal Government Relations for Sprint Corporation in Washington, DC. In this role, he was responsible for advocating regulatory policy before the FCC, members of the telecommunications industry and the U.S. Congress.

Jeff joined Embarq's predecessor company in 1989 and has experience in the areas of finance, wholesale markets, consumer markets and regulatory & external affairs. He has represented local, long distance and wireless operating groups.

Jeff played an integral role in Sprint's initial launch of offering its long distance services in its ILEC territories, its first bundled product offerings, and its wireless operating group's launch of nationwide pricing. He has also managed regulatory reductions on Embarq's operations and achieved cost recovery for implementation of new government-mandated regulations.
