Jill Mendoza is founder and president of i.d.o. Incorporated (Innovative Design Offerings,) an Indianapolis-based commercial interior design firm committed to sustainable design practices. In 2007, Jill and her team demonstrated their long-standing commitment to environmentally-friendly design when i.d.o. Incorporated became Indianapolis' first Leadership in Energy and Environmental Design Commercial Interiors (LEED CI) Silver certified building.

In planning the headquarters relocation from Indianapolis' south side to 601 North Capitol, Jill's team worked closely to leverage LEED guidelines in the planning, design and refurbishing of the office space. Jill believes that one of the biggest misconceptions inhibiting the progress of sustainable building is the perception that green building is expensive. The flexibility of the LEED program allows businesses to select the options that will work within their budget and more importantly, see how environmentally smart choices today can provide energy savings in the future.

A graduate of Purdue University, Jill founded i.d.o. Incorporated in 1992. The firm has carved out strong niches in the corporate, health care, education, non-profit, and hospitality markets, while establishing solid relationships with architecture design firms throughout Indiana.

Jill is involved in the design community as well as the community at large. She is a professional member of the IIDA, the International Interior Design Association, NAWBO, the National Association of Women Business Owners and her firm is a national member of the USGBC, United States Green Building Council. She has been awarded the Interior Design Professional Certification from the National Council of Interior Design Qualification. She also serves on the board of Indiana's Interior Design Coalition.

Locally, Jill has certified i.d.o. Incorporated as a Woman Business Enterprise (WBE) service trade. The WBE certification allows i.d.o. to provide quality commercial interior design services while also helping their clients achieve minority participation requirements.
