

## Department of Technology Scholarships For The 2010 / 2011 Academic Year

Scholarships will be awarded to students in the Department of Technology at the annual Spring Awards Ceremony held Sunday, April 18, 2010 at 1:00 PM. The number and amount of the awards are dependent upon the funds available. The award criteria includes:

- 1) Applicants must be majoring (or registered to major) in a program in the Department of Technology.
- 2) Applicants should have an academic ratio of 3.0 or better (on a 4.0 scale).
- 3) Students must have shown qualities of leadership and personality that will predict success in her / his chosen field.
