#### History

Calvin C. Crooks was born in Delaware County, Ohio in 1829. Later, he moved to Indiana where he spent most of his life and married several times. Eventually, Mr. Crooks and associate Adam Wolfe opened a successful general store in Granville, Indiana called, Calvin C. Crooks and Company.

From 1872 to 1882, Crooks kept a daily diary which detailed local weather information and in later years, "events of the day".

The date of Crooks death is uncertain.

#### Scope and Content

The Calvin C. Crooks Collection contains journals written during the years of 1872 to 1882. These journals consist of weather information recorded by Crooks as well a daily diary and expense records.
