History

America's Hometown Band was formed in 1985 as a not-for-profit organization to provide an opportunity for local music professionals, educators, and amateurs to perform for their own and the community's enjoyment. The band, regularly a seventeen or eighteen member dance band performs several shows every year, and grows to a sixty member concert band for special occasions like the Fourth of July Prelude and the New Year's Eve Dance. All of the proceeds from the band's performances are used to help the band continue their service to the Muncie and Delaware County community.

Scope and Content

This collection consists of the organizational papers of the America's Hometown Band, spanning the years 1994 to 2006. Included in the papers are programs and fliers for various performances, correspondence, board meeting minutes, financial reports and dance committee meeting minutes.
