## History

Oscar W. Crabbs was born on a farm near Dayton, Ohio. He came in Muncie, Indiana in 1892 and went into the hay and grain business. Crabbs served as superintendent of Beech Gove Cemetary and the city parks in Muncie, Indiana, overseeing the development of McCulloch, Heekin and Rose Parks. He also served as superintendent of the grounds at Ball State College and Ball Memorial Hospital. Crabbs also served as a member of the city council and the board of park commissioners.

The collection contains the O.W. Crabbs scrapbook. It includes newspaper clippings documenting Crabbs' career and family.
