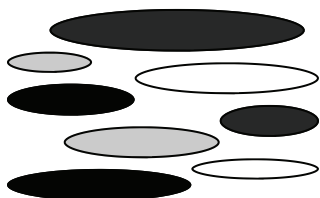

Architecture Library web site revised

The Architecture Library web site has been revised to feature quick links to resources and more research tips. On the "Find Books" and "Find Articles" pages library users can follow the links to resources highlighted in a central column on the page. Tips for

using the resources are found in a second column.

There are also several new features on the site including links to subject guides (see page 2 for more details) and a list of videos in the Architecture Library. The video list provides up-to-date infor-

mation via CardCat about all of the DVD and video titles in the Architecture Library.

Login to access more CardCat features

Library users have the option of logging in to use CardCat with a BSU username and password, or using CardCat without logging in. There are several features available to those who log in:

1. **View and renew materials.** Click on "My Library Account"

to see a list of materials currently checked out to your account. You may renew these materials online in CardCat.

2. **Access Course Reserves.** Click on

"Course Reserves and search by instructor or course name for a list of items on reserve and links to e-reserves.

3. **Recall checked out materials.** When viewing the detailed record for a checked-out item, simply click on "Recall/Hold request" to place a recall. Choose either the Architecture Library or Bracken Library as the pick-up location. You will receive an email when the item is available for pick-up.

Subject guides feature library resources

The Architecture Library subject guides for architecture, landscape architecture, urban planning, and historic preservation point students to resources in the library and online. The guides bring together research resources in an easy-to-use page organized by tabs (see

below). The subject guides may be quickly updated to accommodate new database subscriptions and print resources added to the library collection.

Topics covered in the guides include article databases, firm and designer directories, code books and standards, and

history and theory texts in each of the disciplines. Image sources, including the Visual Resources Collections' Architecture Image collection are also covered.
