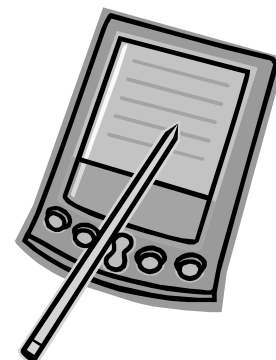
From the Librarian's Desk

BuildingGreen Suite

The *BuildingGreen Suite* offers information on sustainable design and materials. Articles

from the *Environmental Building News*, entries from the *Green-Spec* directory of building products, and case studies are both searchable and grouped by topic.

Web of Science

The *Web of Science* contains entries from the Arts & Humanities Citation Index and

the Social Sciences Citation Index from 1992 to the present. The Web of Science links to related citations to and from each article and the Find It @ BSU button locates the article in the library or assists with interlibrary loan requests. Bracken Library offers classes on searching the *Web of Science*. See p. 2 for more information.

Quickly Download Architecture Images

Looking for a way to quickly download images from the Architecture Images Collection? The Architecture Image Retriever can do just that.

Developed by staff in the University Libraries Library Information Technology Services department, the plug-in is now available for use with PowerPoint. Download the

plug-in to your computer and use it to insert images from the Architecture Images Collection directly into a PowerPoint presentation.



Here's how: using a PC and Internet Explorer, save images to My Favorites while searching the Architecture Images Collection. Next,

open PowerPoint and click on the Architecture Image Retriever tab. Follow the steps and the plug-in will download full size images from your selected My Favorites.

E-Reserves Continue to Grow

The popularity of e-reserves continues to grow. Architecture Library items on e-reserve increased from 164 in the fall semester of 2005 to 264 in the fall semester of 2006. Overall, items on reserve rose 14% from 877 items in the fall of 2005 to 1006 items in the fall of 2006.

Placing an item on e-reserve is easy. Simply stop by the li-

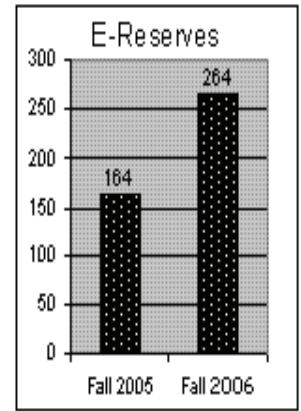
brary or contact Helen Ulrich, Architecture Library Coordinator (HUlrich@bsu.edu, 5-5857). Copyright restrictions limit each e-reserve item to one article from an issue of a journal or one chapter or 10% of a book.

Once an item is on e-reserve, it may be conveniently accessed online through the "Reserve

Desk" in CardCat. The "Reserve Desk" also lists the books, videos, and other materials that are on reserve in the library.



Remember: As with all reserves, be sure to submit e-reserve requests 3-7 days before they are needed to allow time for scanning and processing.



Reserve or "Book" Videos for Class Viewings

Videos may be reserved or "booked" for class viewings on specific dates. By booking a video you are insuring that it will be available to present to a class on a scheduled date.

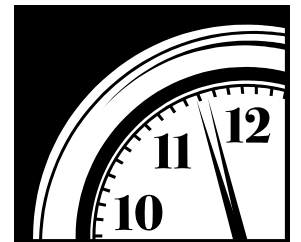

You will receive an email confirmation of the booking. On the day specified, videos may be picked up at their home locations (Architecture Library or Educational Resources in the basement of Bracken Library). Videos check out for 3 days and

may be returned to any library on campus.

Videos in the Architecture Library may also be presented via the Video Information System (VIS). Call VIS at 285-9136 and VIS personnel will book the video and arrange for it to be shown in the classroom.

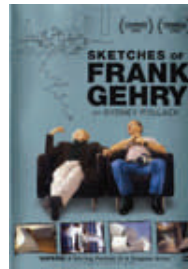
