

Character Charts

1. You will need a person-sized piece of butcher paper.
2. Choose a student to lie on the butcher paper.
3. Have a second student trace around the outside of the student lying on the butcher paper.
4. Have the same two students cut out the outline of the person.
5. Write the name of the character from the book on the face of the person outline.
6. Hang the person outline on a wall, bulletin board, or chalkboard.
7. Have all the students write one character trait on a Post-It note and stick it to the person outline.

Repeat these steps for all the characters in the book. We are going to make more character charts as we read the novel. In addition, we will add more traits as we read.
