

EXTENDED CONTINUING AND DISTANCE EDUCATION COMMITTEE

- 4.1 The membership of the committee shall consist of the following elected, designated, and ex officio members:
 - 4.11 Six members from the Academic Policies Council;
 - 4.12 Seven faculty with primary assignment in a college, elected one per college, for staggered three-year terms;
 - 4.13 One undergraduate and one graduate student chosen annually by the Student Government Association;
 - 4.14 The Dean of the School of Extended Education by virtue of the position.

- 4.2 The Extended Continuing and Distance Education Committee is responsible for carrying out on a continuing basis the following initiatives and activities:
 - 4.21 To initiate and recommend policies and procedures for the administration of extended ~~extension, continuing and distance~~ education programs of the University;
 - 4.22 To provide a means for adequate interpretation of the programs and to receive and consider recommendations for revisions and improvements in them;
 - 4.23 To conduct a continuous evaluation of extended ~~extension, continuing and distance~~ education at the University.
