The members of the University Senate recognize with regret the death of:

Dr. Jerry M. Anderson, 9th President of Ball State University.

Dr. Anderson died at the age of 74 in Amery, Wisconsin. Dr. Anderson, whose doctorate was from Michigan State University, served as the Vice-Chancellor at the University of Wisconsin-Oshkosh before being chosen from over 240 candidates as BSU president. Dr. Anderson was elected to the presidency in 1979 and served until his resignation in 1981. Among his other accomplishments as a teacher, scholar, and administrator, Dr. Anderson is credited with the renewal of campus and community interest in Christy Woods and with refusing to eliminate its acreage.
