***John Warner**, Department of Technology. Mr. Warner passed away late December after a brief illness. He was 65. Designing and building were his avocations as well as his vocation. He was a faculty member in Art from 1970-1976 and in Technology from 2000 until his passing. Colleagues remember him as having “passion for teaching. John literally put everything he had into what he referred to as the ‘art of teaching’ and the ongoing development of the construction management program.
