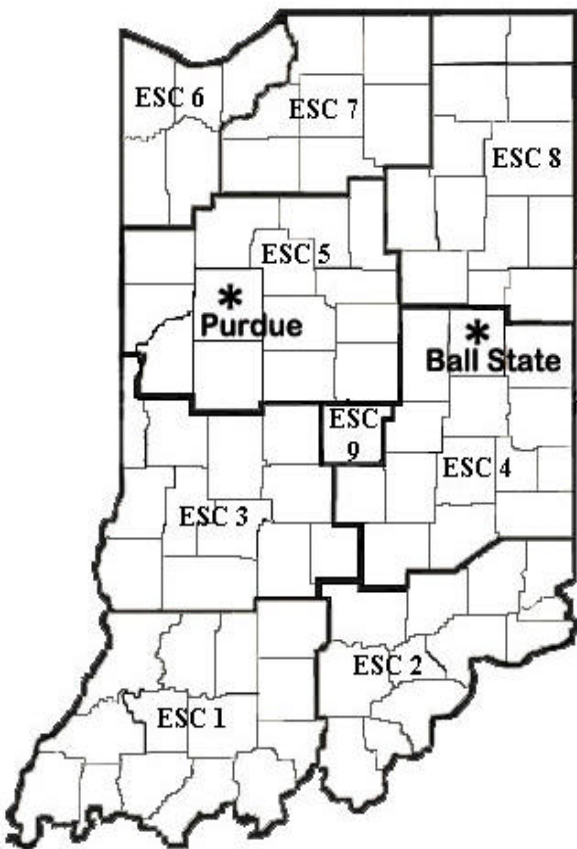

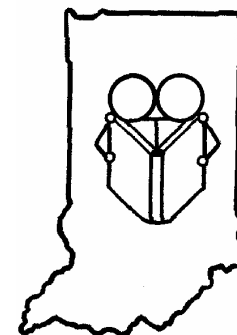

## RESOURCES

**Shared Information Services** centers are located at two sites that serve the entire state of Indiana. We are lending libraries who loan educational materials, **free of charge**, to educators, parents, and college/university students throughout the state. Our resources include materials appropriate for preschool through high school, adult, and professional levels. Our holdings cover a wide variety of topics, such as:
