

Fall Semester Next Steps

For Faculty

- Learn and make full use of campus technology tools, especially Canvas and WebEx.
- Consult and participate in faculty development opportunities and consultations provided by DOSL.
- Front load course student learning outcomes during the first portion of the semester, utilizing the second half of the semester to encourage students to practice and master course goals.
- Learn about ways to connect students to important support resources, including the **Counseling Center**, the **Dean of Students**, and **the Office of Retention and Graduation**.

For Chairs, Directors, and Deans

- With faculty, review schedule to distribute courses more broadly (evenings, weekends) to promote social distancing.
- Review existing academic policies, including policies pertaining to Incomplete grades and medical withdrawals, to guide and support faculty and students.
- Consider how to evaluate, support, and advance the effects of increased professional development and practice of Online delivery.
- Prepare to hold all unit, committee, and other meetings virtually.
- Develop a plan for regular communication and check-ins with faculty members.
