### **Accreditation**

In the United States, most state registration boards require a degree from an accredited professional degree program as a prerequisite for licensure. The National Architectural Accrediting Board (NAAB), which is the sole agency authorized to accredit U.S. professional degree programs in architecture, recognizes three types of degrees: the Bachelor of Architecture, the Master of Architecture, and the Doctor of Architecture. A program may be granted a six-year, three-year, or two-year term of accreditation, depending on its degree of conformance with established educational standards.

Doctor of Architecture and Master of Architecture degree programs may consist of a pre-professional undergraduate degree and a professional graduate degree that, when earned sequentially, constitute an accredited professional education. However, the pre-professional degree is not, by itself, recognized as an accredited degree.

Ball State University, Department of Architecture offers the following NAAB-accredited degree programs:

- M.Arch (pre-professional degree + 57 graduate credits)
- M.Arch (non-pre-professional degree + 99 graduate credits)

### **M.Arch Program**

Our graduate degree aims to develop a student's capacity for creative, cumulative and critical thinking, design literacy, and lifelong cultivation of design capabilities. Accredited by NAAB, the degree program is for students who seek professional licensure. We offer two tracks for completing the M.Arch professional degree.

A three-year track or the two-year track for undergraduates with a pre-professional degree in architecture.


