1 DAVID ROWE

David Rowe is one of two artists this year that are a part of the NEA funded Ball State PlySpace Artist-In-Residence Program. As an artist, David is a sculptor, educator, and fabricator. His work explores landscape, history, and the transitory spaces within the American psyche. He is a 2011 recipient of an Efraymon Family Fund Fellowship, and a 2015 recipient of a Nevada Arts Council Fellowship. His work was included in the traveling show "Crafting a Continuum". He is currently an Assistant Professor in Sculptural Practices at the University of Nevada Las Vegas and holds a BFA from the University of Illinois at Urbana-Champaign and an MFA from Indiana University Bloomington.

2 KEVIN BOWMAN

Kevin Bowman is an accomplished printmaking professor at Montgomery College in Maryland. His work has been widely exhibited and he is an expert in all printmaking processes. He has helped many well known artists make prints. He will lecture on his work and the history of printmaking.

3 ADAM HOLTZINGER

Adam Holtzinger earned his BFA in Glass from the Cleveland Institute of Art before moving to Brooklyn, NY to pursue a career in glass blowing. Adam designs and fabricates work for designers and artists, as well as other glassmakers. Adam served as head Gaffer for Niche Modern Design from 2003 through August 2014. He currently lives in Brooklyn, NY where he makes custom work for designers and is a founding partner of KEEP, a Brooklyn-based lighting company.

4 FEDERICO CUATLACUATL

Federico Cuatlatl is a Mexican Indigenous artist born in Cholula, Puebla. He immigrated to Indiana and received a BFA from Ball State University and an MFA specializing in Digital Arts at Bowling Green State University in Ohio. Federico's work disseminates topics of Latinx immigration, social art practice, and cultural sustainability. Building from his own experience growing up as an undocumented immigrant and currently holding DACA. As founder and director of the Rasquache Artist Residency in Puebla, Mexico, he actively stays involved in socially engaged works and binational endeavors.

5 RON DICK

Ron Dick is a glass artist who worked for Fenton Art Glass Company in West Virginia. The company was one of the largest manufacturers of handmade colored glass in the United States and is renowned for innovative glass color, as well as pressed and blown glassware. Ron Dick is the third generation of glassworkers in his family with over forty years experience working as a glass presser at Fenton. With his years of experience and knowledge, Ron has taught glass workers at Fenton Art Glass and other studio glass artists the process of hand press glass.

6 YOUNG JOO LEE

Young Joo Lee lives and works in Los Angeles. She earned a BFA in painting from Hongik Arts University, Korea, a Meisterschülerin in Film from Städelschule, Frankfurt Germany, and a MFA in Sculpture from Yale University. She finds inspiration in her dreams and personal and political histories to create sculptures, drawings, and performative pieces. Her work explores how our environments are not only outside of us but how they truly alter our perception as a whole, informing our personal identities. She recently taught workshops on narrative possibilities in virtual reality and immersive cinema as a visiting artist at Yale University Center for Collaborative Arts and Media.

7 TERI CAMPBELL

Teri Campbell is a Cincinnati based visual artist and author. He has been called a lighting master and has been named one of the 200 best digital artists worldwide by Archive Magazine. His company, Teri Studios has become a destination for consumer-packaged goods companies. Clients include KFC, Burger King, Marzetti, Kraft-Heinz, Red Gold Tomatoes, Kellogg's and Hershey's. He is also the author of Food Photography and Lighting: A Commercial Photographers Guide to Creating Irresistible Images.

8 GRETCHEN GOSS

Gretchen Goss is Professor and Chair of the Material Culture Environment at the Cleveland Institute of Art. Her work has been supported by Ohio Arts Council and included in exhibits nationally and internationally. In 2003 she was co-curator for Metalsmith Magazine's Exhibition in Print titled, "Enameling; a current perspective". She was curator for three subsequent exhibits and has been a visiting artist, lecturer, and taught numerous workshops on enameling nationally and in the UK.

9 ALLI HOAG

Alli Hoag's artistic practice is concerned with themes of magic. She attempts to create moments where one can believe that distance is overcome. Alli works across mediums of glass, installation, video, performance and digital technology to investigate this uniquely human desire, and to reveal the simultaneous lightness and heaviness that is created when the imagined or invisible is labored into the physical realm. Alli completed her BFA degree in Glass at University of Hawaii at Manoa, and graduated from New York State College of Ceramics in 2012. She was a 2015 Emerging Artist by the Glass Art Society and is Head of the Glass Program at Bowling Green State University.

10 JOE SOLA

Joe Sola lives in Los Angeles. He has participated in various international institutional group exhibitions including: Kunsthaus Graz, Austria (2014), Musée d'Art Moderne Grand-Duc Jean, Luxembourg City, Luxembourg (2014), as well as many national exhibitions. His performances have been shown at 356 Mission Road, Los Angeles, (2013), MOT International, London (2010). His work is included in many public museums, including LACMA, MOMA.

11 JOHN POMEROY

John Pomeroy is an American animator, producer, writer, storyboard artist, character designer, and painter. He has worked for Walt Disney Studios as well as Don Bluth Studios in Ireland. He was mentored under famed animator Frank Thomas, one of Walt Disney's Nine Old Men. His career spans between the end of the Golden age of animation to today's current feature length animated films. He has worked on animated films such as: Winnie the Pooh and Tigger Too, The Many Adventures of Winnie the Pooh, Pete's Dragon, The Fox and the Hound, Dragon's Lair, The Land Before Time, Pocahontas, Fantasia 2000, Atlantis: The Lost Empire, Treasure Planet, Curious George, and The Simpsons Movie.

12 BRYONY GOMEZ-PALACIO

Bryony Gomez-Palacio is a graphic designer and writer now living in Bloomington, IN. She is co-founder of Under Consideration, a graphic design firm and publishing enterprise all rolled into one. Bryony has co-authored five books with her husband and partner, Armin Vit, their most popular titles being Graphic Design, Referenced and the self-published Flaunt. Most recently, they conceived and presented the Brand New Conference, the Brand New Awards, the FPO Awards, and the recently launched lecture series by The Austin Initiative for Graphic Awesomeness. Bryony enjoys conducting workshops and lecturing when not tending to her two young daughters and their crazy schedules.

13 ED HALTER

Ed Halter is a critic and curator living in New York City, and a founder and director of Light Industry, a venue for film and electronic art in Brooklyn, New York. His publications include From Sun Tzu to Xbox: War and Video Games (2006), Mass Effect: Art and the Internet in the 21st Century (2015, with Lauren Cornell), and over two decades of writing. He also programmed and oversaw the New York Underground Film Festival, and has curated screenings and exhibitions at Artists Space, BAM Cinematek, the Flaherty Film Seminar, the ICA, London, Miguel Abreu Gallery, Mass Art Film Society, the Museum of Modern Art, the New Museum, PARTICIPANT INC., the San Francisco Cinematheque, Tate Modern, and the Walker Art Center.
