DAVID W. FORD AND N. MAXINE FORD MEMORIAL AWARD -The David W. and N. Maxine Ford awards remember the memory of a Patriarch and Matriarch of the David Ford Family. David was a Masters' Degree'd Electrical Engineer who designed radios, communications equipment and other electronics at Collins Radio, Philco/Ford and Magnavox (in Fort Wayne). He was privileged to help design, assemble and apply radios in the X-15 Rocket-plane program. The X-15 was flown by future first-man-on-the-moon, Neil Armstrong, so my father was part of the team that provided NASA and its pilots with technology for their missions. The Mach-6 x-15 was the highest flying vehicle until the space program. David was the best engineer I've ever known and the finest father who always had time to answer my questions. It was very rare that he couldn't answer them immediately. On those rare occasions, he'd say, "Let's talk about that tomorrow night," and by tomorrow night he was an expert on the subject. I don't know how he did it, but he always did. Maxine, my mother (she went by her middle name), was a school teacher for more than 35 years and a volunteer at Parkview Hospital in Fort Wayne for more than 30 years. She set high expectations for my sister and me, and uncompromisingly expected us to do our very best. We are blessed that David and Maxine made an incredible parental team. Since science, technology, engineering, math and learning were heavily promoted, it is only fitting that we remember them with the David W. and N. Maxine Ford with STEM awards.
