- Travel will reflect more sustainable options when possible (ex. giving preference to the hybrid car when using the university fleet, choosing green hotels, using teleconferencing or videoconference instead of travel when possible, carpooling, etc.)
- Encourage University Advancement departments to use washable dinnerware for departmental gatherings.
- Decrease energy consumption at the Alumni Center.
