### **Jim Lowe**

His continuing efforts to assess and improve energy utilization by facilities on the Ball State campus; most recently leading the design and construction of the geothermal district heating and cooling system which will ultimately reduce Ball State's CO2 emissions by 50%.

### **Mary McConnell**

As a champion for environmental conservation and sustainability through her ongoing work with The Nature Conservancy to conserve and protect Indiana's natural lands, including forests, wetlands, prairies and rivers.

### **Verallia/Saint Gobain**

Through a wide range of energy-awareness programs, process improvements, and energy management practices, Saint-Gobain businesses in North America were able to reduce their energy intensity (the amount of energy used to produce a unit of product) by 3.8 percent and reduced their carbon dioxide emissions by more than 131,000 tons last year.
