# A Bike Lane on Oakwood Avenue A Resolution Adopted September 9, 2013

**Whereas** Ball State University, as a signatory of the American College & University Presidents Climate Commitment, and a leader among universities in the areas of sustainability; and

**Whereas** Muncie is a city interested in creating bike lanes on its streets as a way for residents to improve their health, save money and enhance the appeal of the city; and

Whereas Ball State faculty and staff living in Halteman Village and Norwood Addition and the potential of more than 600 students living in the new apartment complex called the Grove at McGalliard and Oakwood might ride their bikes to campus if there was a bike lane on Oakwood to provide safer passage;

**Now therefore be it resolved** that the Council on the Environment recommends:

That the appropriate representative from Ball State University's Department of Facilities and Planning Management requests that the City of Muncie plan to include a bike lane on Oakwood between Wheeling and Bethel when the road is repaved and repainted and that a flashing yellow light be installed and a crosswalk painted at Bethel and Oakwood avenues for the well-being of cyclists.
