




Figure A-2: CAST departmental student credit hour production - last 10 years


Figure A-3: CAST trend for declared undergraduate and graduate majors - last 8 years

Figure A-4: CAST departmental data for declared undergrad/graduate majors - last 8 years












Figure C-3 - CAST 4 YR ATE Ratios For Scholarship


