As Percent of 2001 Q1 Level, U.S. and Indiana

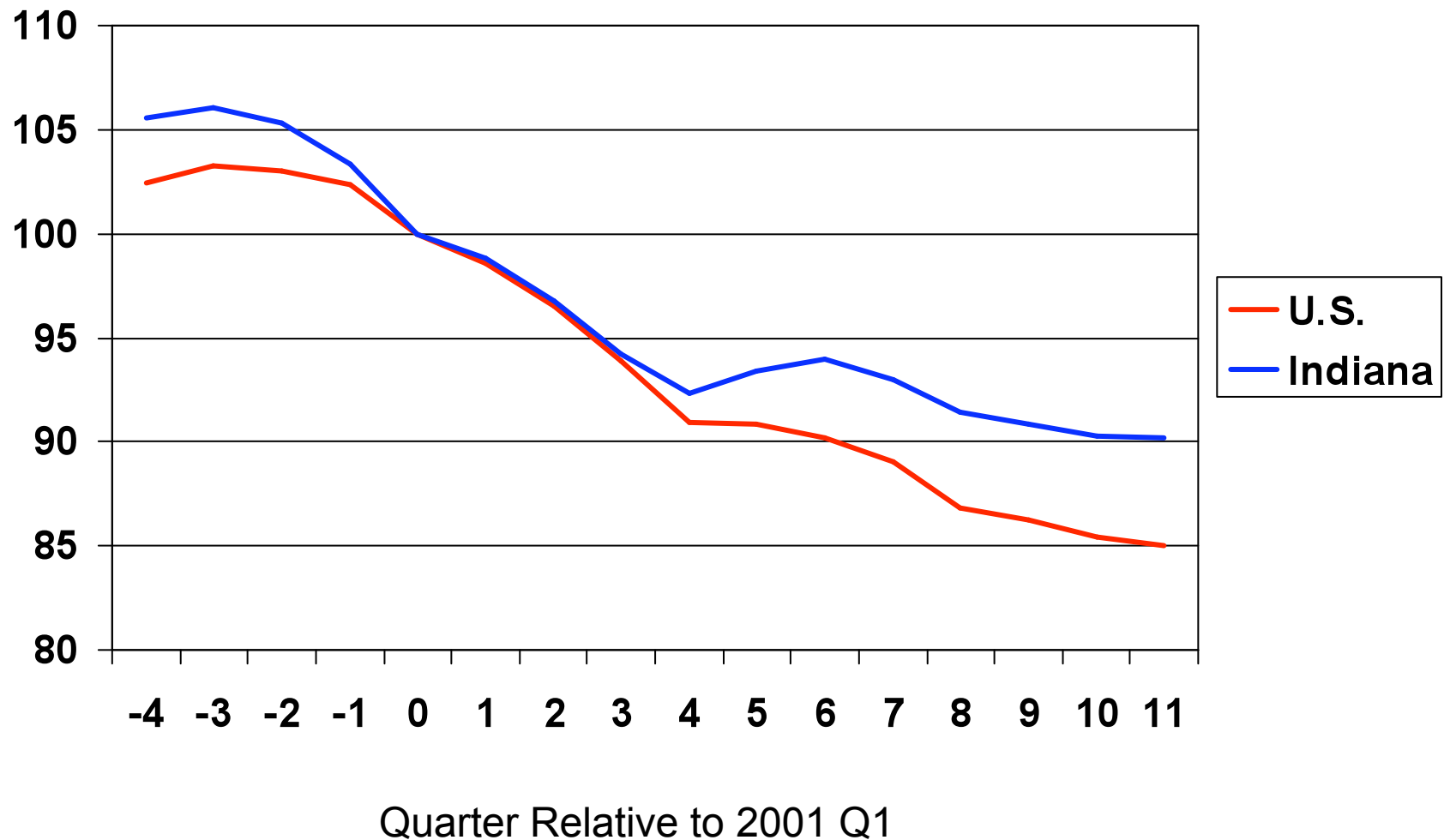
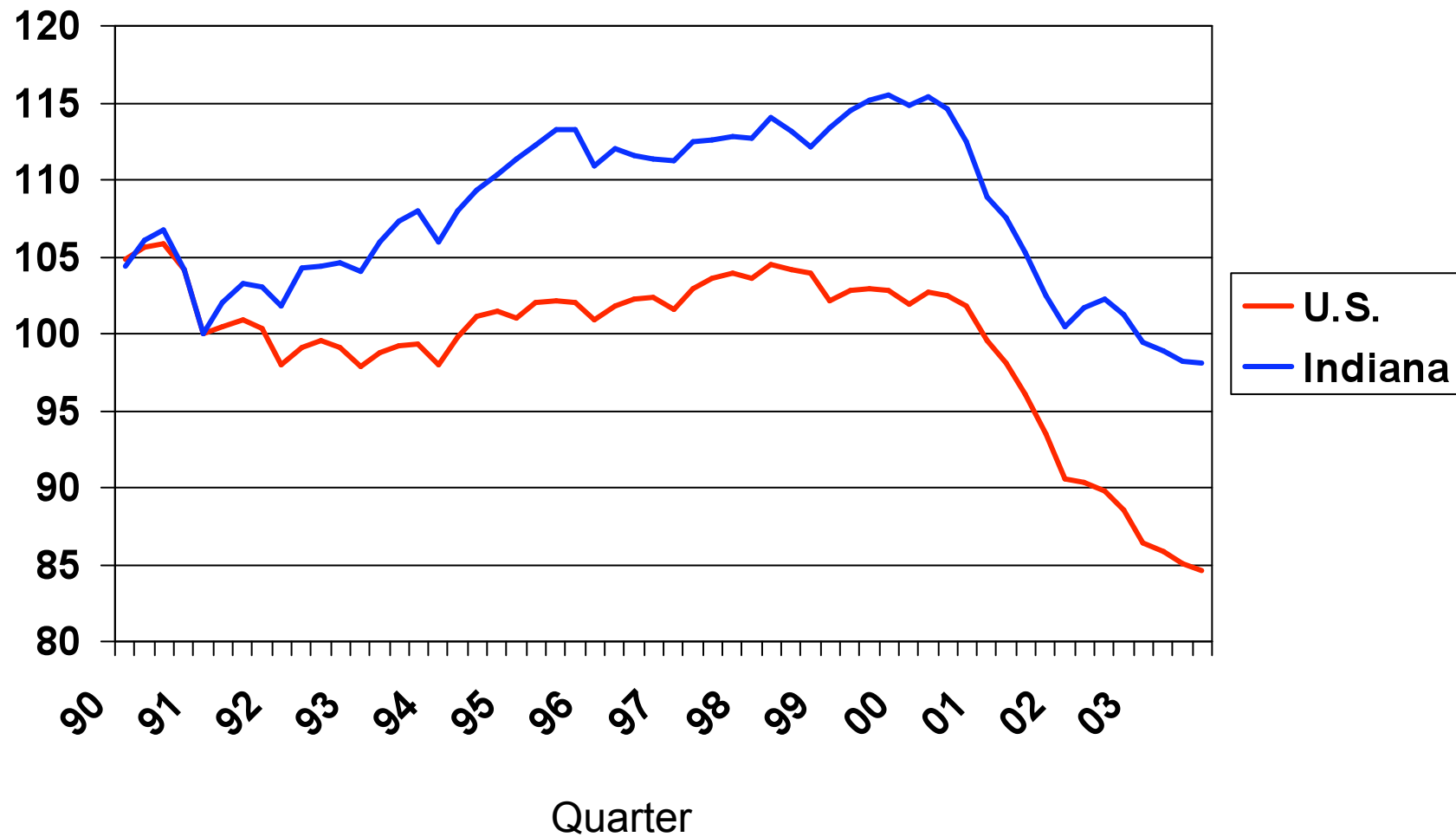
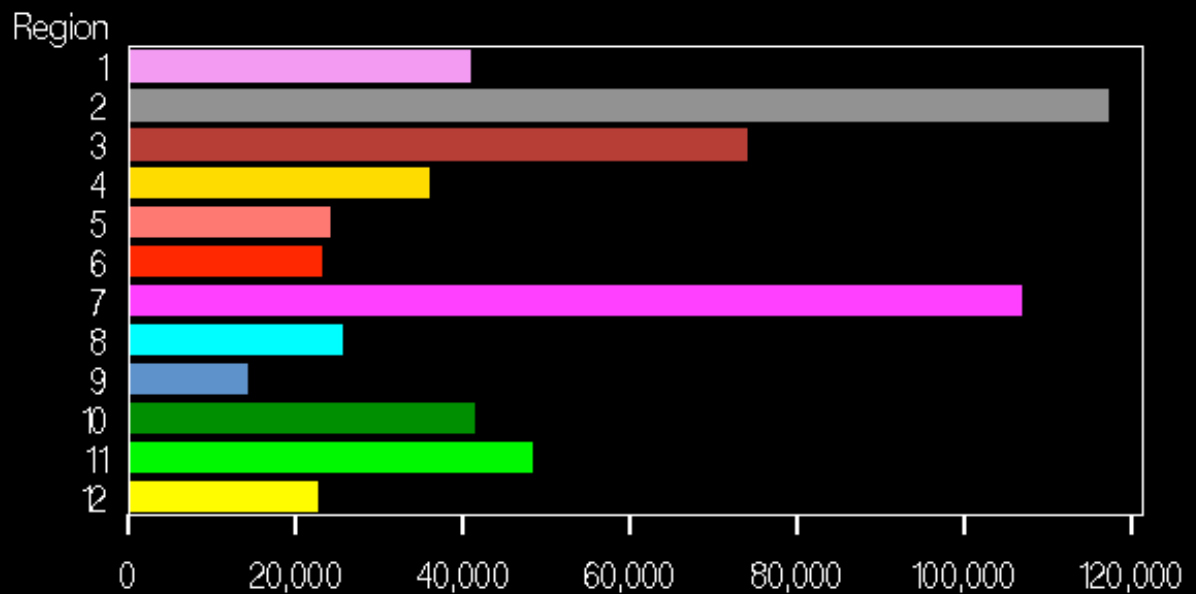
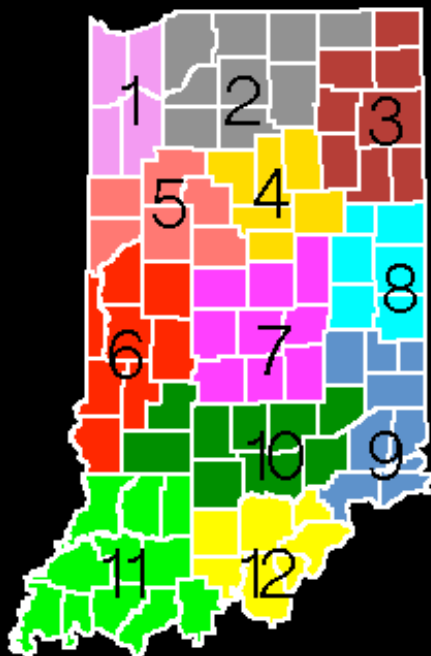

As Percent of 1991 Q1 Level, U.S. and Indiana



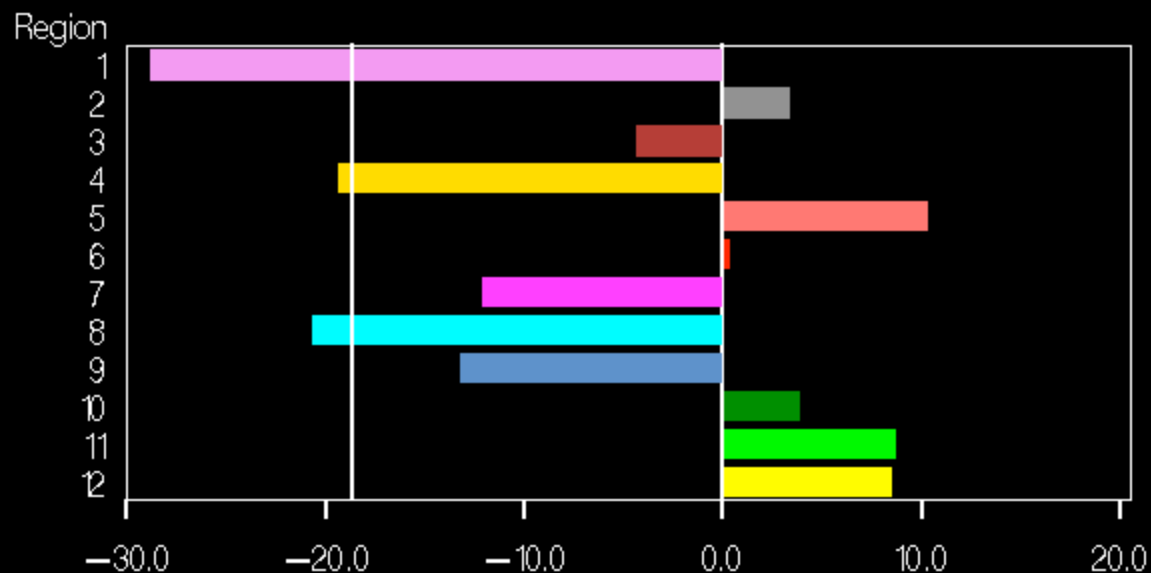
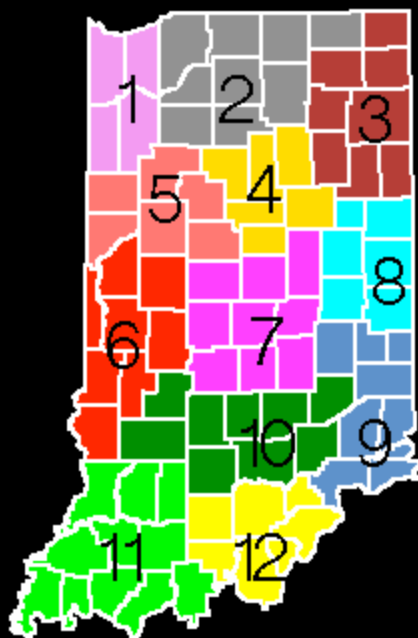

Manufacturing Employment, 2003



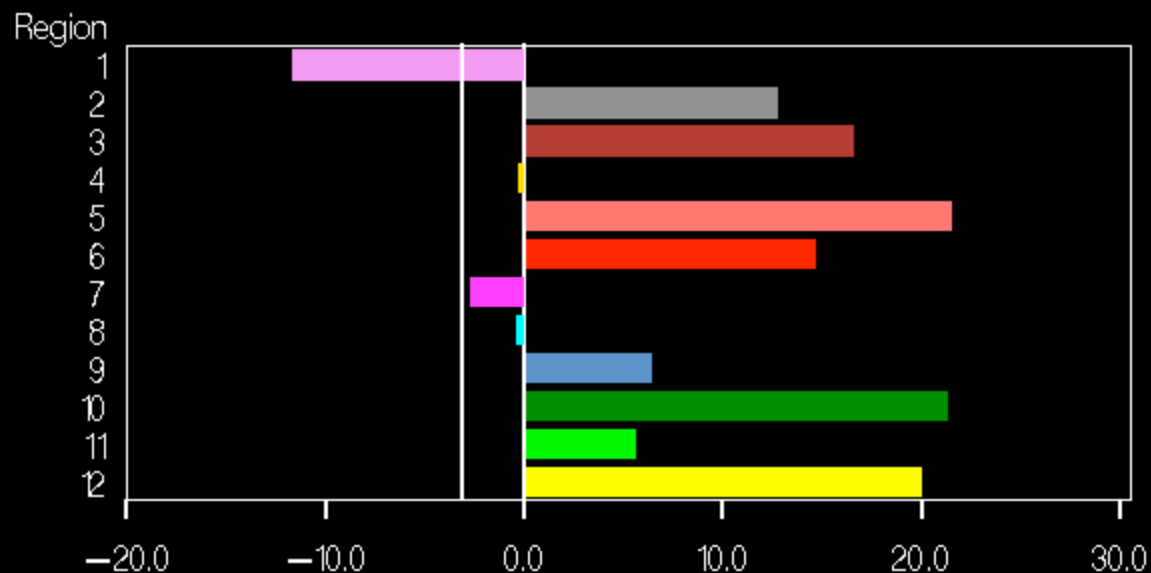

Manufacturing Employment Growth, 1990—2003



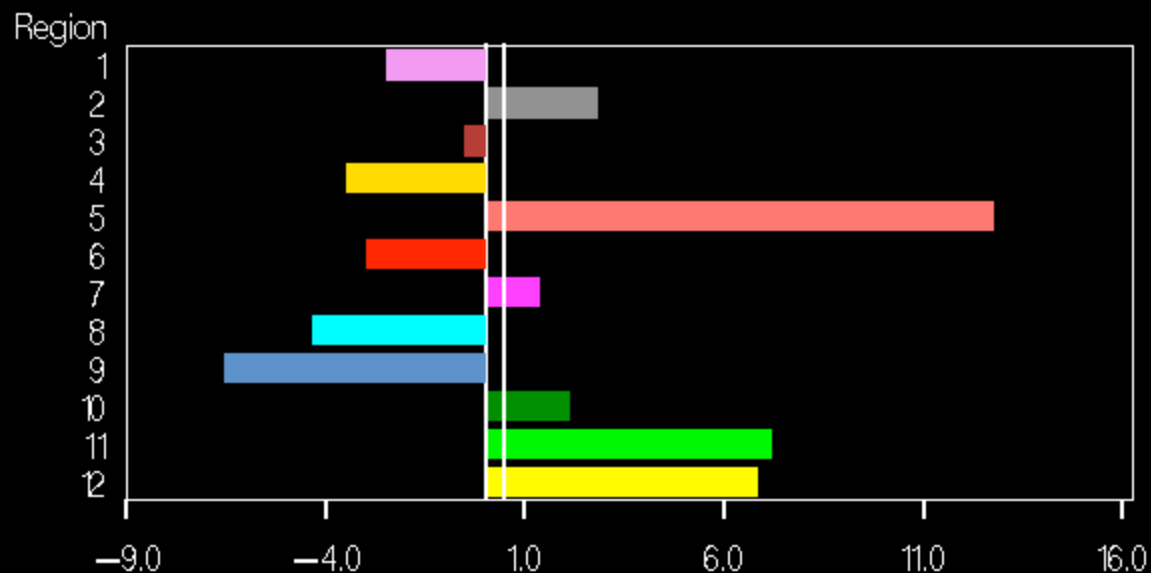

Manufacturing Employment Growth, 1990—95



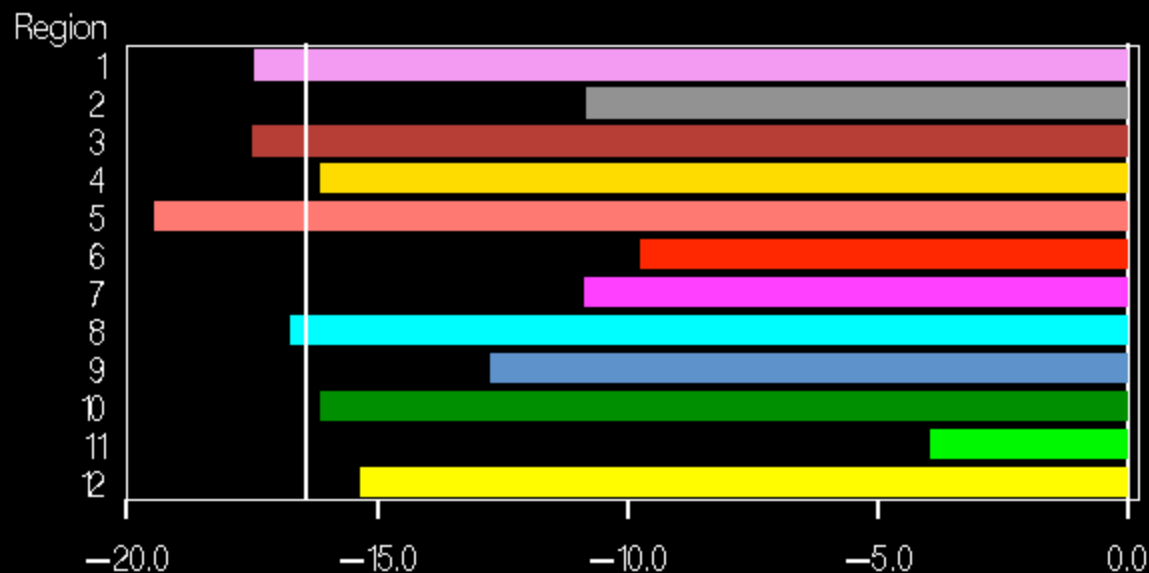

Manufacturing Employment Growth, 1995—2000



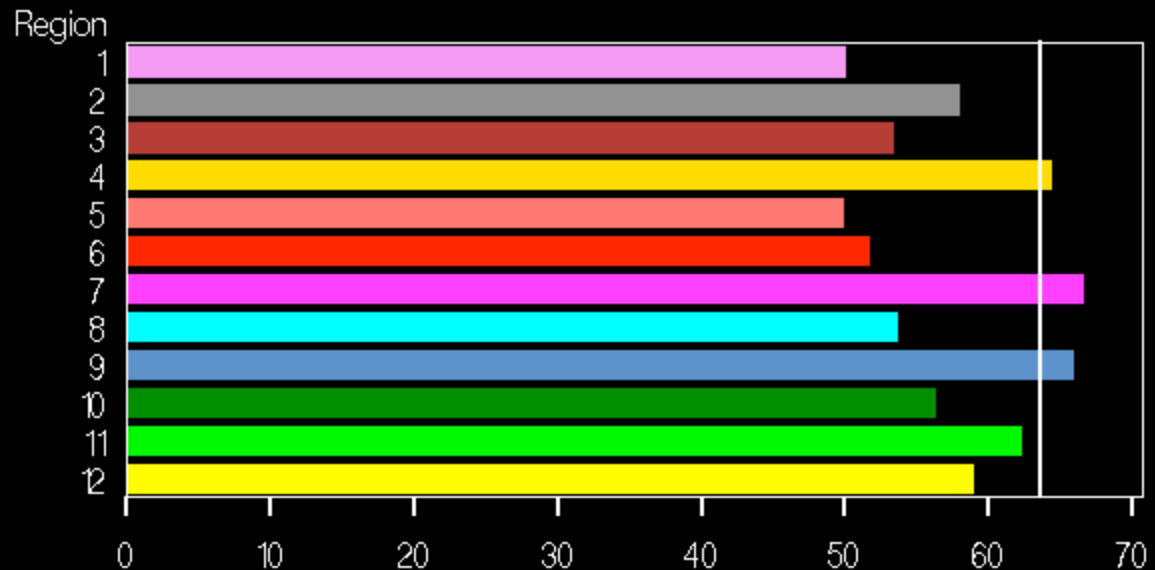

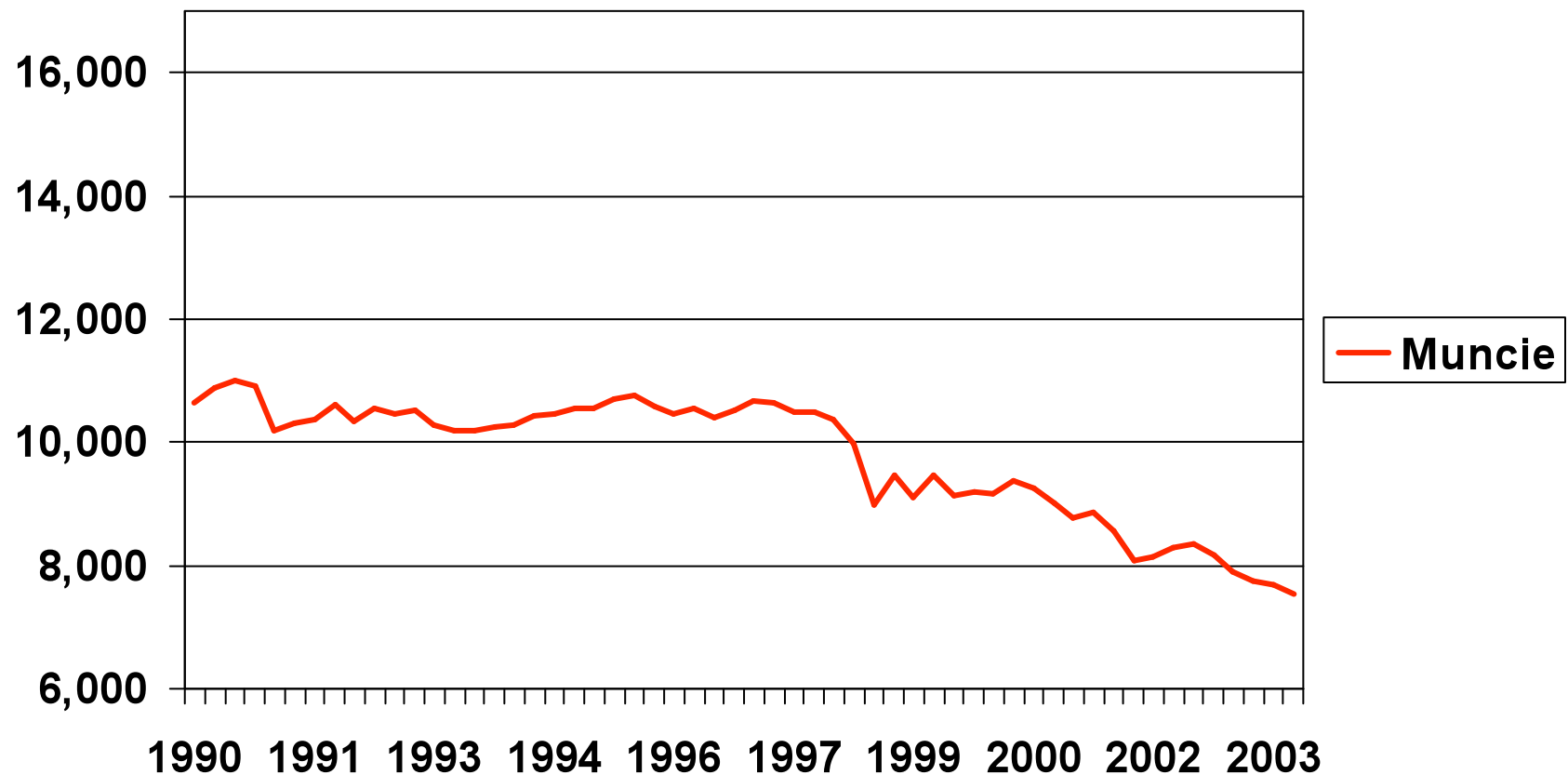

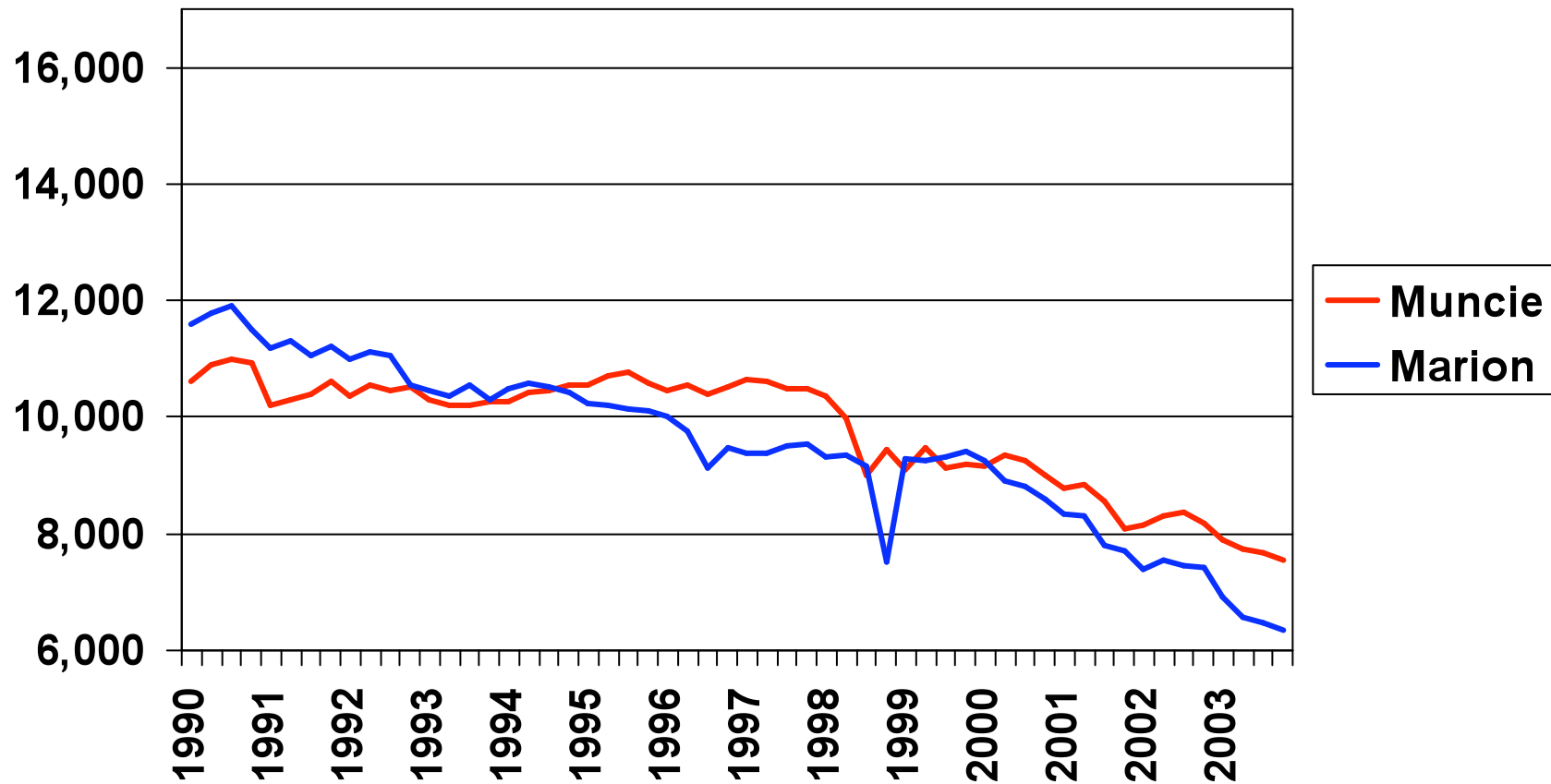
Pct. Growth Manufacturing Earnings Per Job, 1990—2003



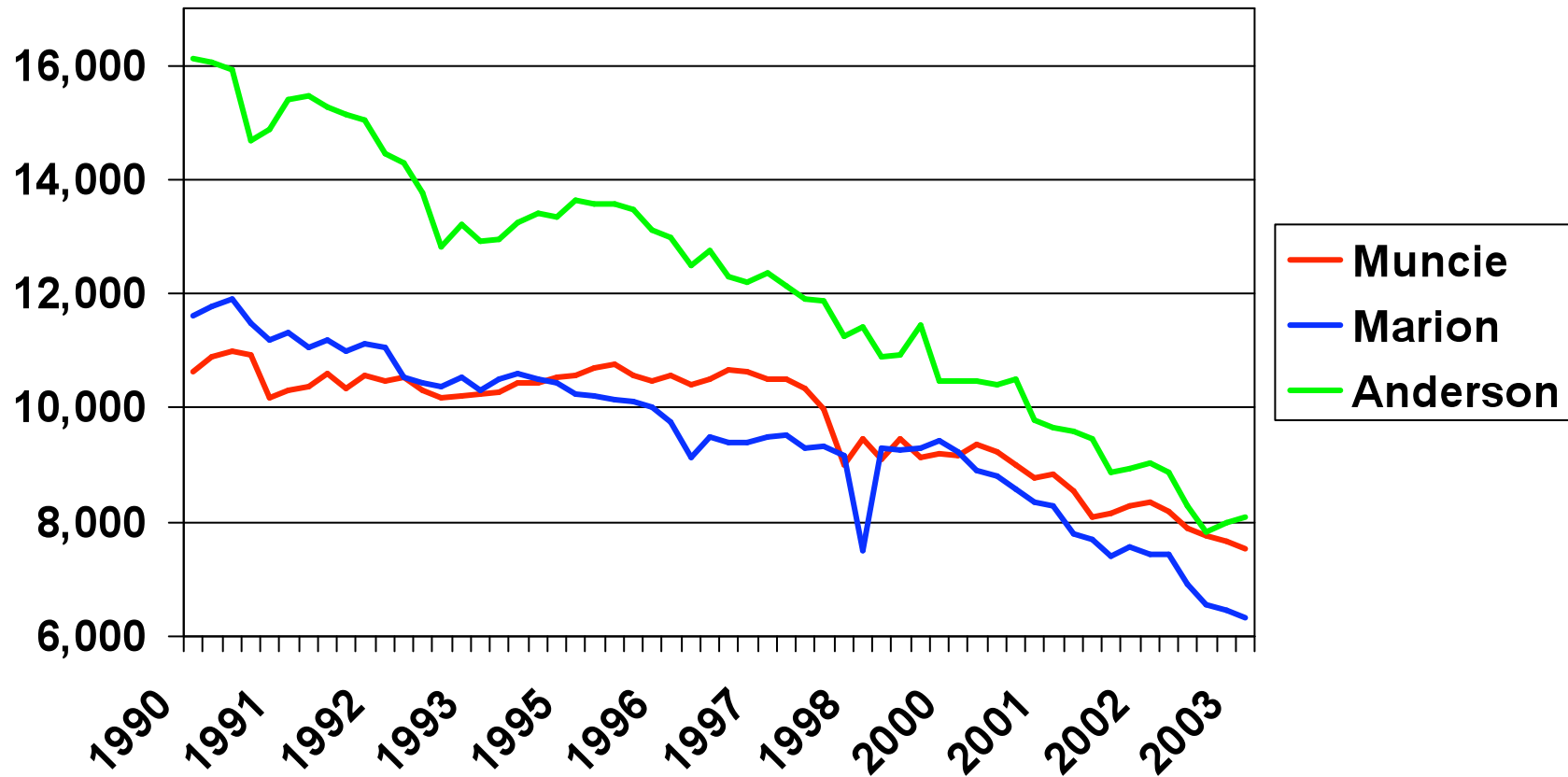

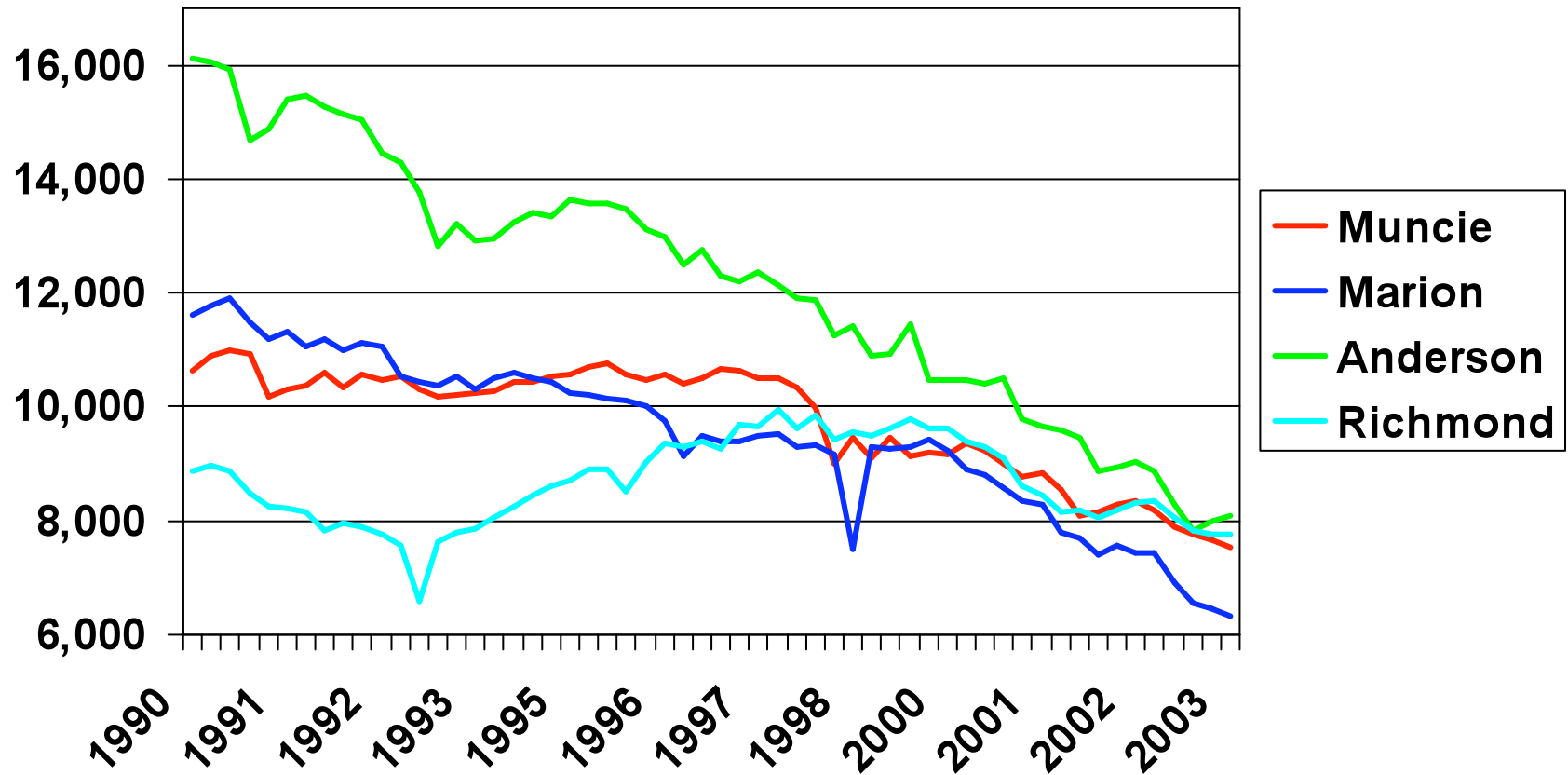
