Students who hold a master's degree from an accredited institution other than Ball State may apply up to 42 of their semester hours to the Ph.D. program; however, they must complete at least two of their four academic training years at Ball State. Prior to enrolling in classes, students are assigned an advisor (usually the program director) who will review approving graduate coursework and develope a preliminary plan of study using the doctoral sequence and advising sheet (Appendix B), which includes a transfer checklist for additional guidance. Once the preliminary plan has been developed, it is submitted to the Director (Name) and the faculty member who has experied to the provide course yillab for all courses they would like transferred to Ball State and/or to meet program requirements for faculty review.
