- First person point of view uses the pronouns I and we. Third person point of view uses the
 pronouns he, she, and they to talk about the protagonist, but choose-your-ownadventures are usually in the second person. This means the author writes the story to
 YOU.
 - a. How did it make you feel to have the author talk to you directly?
 - b. How did it feel when the author had already decided some of the actions that you'd already taken?
- 2. When reading the Super You! books, what did you think of what happened after making a choice?
 - a. What choices did you like?
 - b. Which ones did you not enjoy?
- 3. If you had to choose between the power of flying or invisibility, which would you choose? Explain your answer.
- 4. What would you do if you had that super power?
- 5. What do you think about what the main character of your story did with the power?
- 6. What was unique about this super hero novel compared to others that you've read?

Use your answers to the discussion questions to write a review of your novel.
Be sure to include names of important characters and what you liked about them, conflicts and choices that you liked, and anything that could have made it better. Then conclude by recommending the book to the kind of people who might like to read it too.
