After reading your novel, choose one of the following options for writing your own story.

- 1. Create a graphic novel of your own. Draw characters in panels with dialogue bubbles and captions. Use color. Tell a story in 6-24 panels. It is up to you how many panels are on each page.
 - Consider partnering with a friend on this one. Collaborate on the story, then have one writer and one artist to author and illustrate your novel.
- Write a story about one of Hena Khan's characters from the novel you read. You could write about a supporting character that you'd like to expand on or continue the story from where it ended. (250-500 words)
- 3. Write your own original short story about one of the following themes: working hard, trying to fit in, or accepting your own culture, strengths, and/or weaknesses. (250-1000 words)
