Note: All values noted above represent an unduplicated student headcount. Each cell describes the unique number of students in each department or college disaggregated by level and the modality of their schedule. As this presentation is based on all majors declared as of the census date, including certificates and licensures, students are counted in each department in which they have a declared program, but only once per department and only once per college. Definitions: "Face-to-Face" is a student taking 0 credit hours delivered online; "Blended" is a student whose total credit hours are delivered through any combination of both online and face-to-face methods; "Online" is a student whose total credit hours are only delivered online. This definition differs from that used for prior terms, which was previously based upon course count rather than credit hours.
