## College of Fine Arts' Distinctions

- The School of Music offers a music media production program that blends science and art, encouraging students to explore music with the **latest digital technology**.
- Ball State students provide **one-on-one support and preparation for children with special needs** for an audience of more than 800 with the Prism Project, founded in 2009.
- Since 2004, students from the Department of Theatre and Dance have been invited as **national qualifiers to the yearly Kennedy Center American College Theater Festival**, one of the nation's premier events for collegiate theater programs.
- School of Art students experience **world-class facilities** that support the full range of artistic expression at the bachelor of arts, bachelor of fine arts, and master of fine arts levels. The 9,254-square-foot Marilyn K. Glick Center for Glass is a premier glassmaking facility, and our animation program is nationally ranked.
- The David Owsley Museum of Art (DOMA) displays works in a gallery space that exceeds 26,500 square feet. **Its collection is from around the world, spanning ancient history to modern times.** DOMA loans work for major exhibitions at museums across the country and overseas, including the Louvre Museum in Paris and the Metropolitan Museum of Art in New York.
- Emens Auditorium, Pruis Hall, and the Brown Family Amphitheater provide **state-of-the-art stage/productions and event planning and support services.** The facilities offer an array of guest artists, productions, and celebrities of national and international prominence who represent various genres of live performance and entertainment from traditional to the innovative.
