

Fall 2023 Fraternity & Sorority Life Report Executive Summary

Academics

- The Fall 2023 All-Greek GPA of 3.117 is consistent with the All-BSU average of 3.141.
- The following chapters achieved the highest GPA for their respective council: Lambda Chi Alpha (Interfraternity Council), Zeta Phi Beta (National Pan-Hellenic Council), and Alpha Omicron Pi (Panhellenic Association).

Housing

- Members of Delta Tau Delta, Phi Sigma Kappa, Sigma Alpha Epsilon, Sigma Chi, Sigma Nu and Sigma Phi Epsilon live in houses privately owned or leased by their respective housing corporations.
- Alpha Tau Omega, Sigma Nu and Sigma Phi Epsilon are alcohol-free facilities.

Leadership Development

- More than 700 FSL Leaders participated in our Event Monitor Training that focuses on Alcohol Awareness, Conflict Management, and Risk Management throughout the academic year.
- Our Greek Honor Society, Order of Omega, was re-introduced to our FSL Leaders after a restructuring in their identity, events, and recruitment. Recruiting for Order of Omega began this semester and we were able to recruit 28 new members.
- This February, we were able to take all council executive board members (24 students and 5 staff) to the Association of Fraternal Leadership & Values (AFLV) Central Conference in Indianapolis, Indiana. IFC and PHA both were recognized and won awards for their work during the 2023 year.

Recruitment, Retention & Expansion

- The Greek community totaled 1,233 members during the Fall 2023 semester, up from 1,292 members in Fall 2022. This is a **4.7% decrease** of members.
- Currently 9.19% of Ball State students are members of a fraternity or sorority.
- Three of the nine NPHC fraternities and sororities brought in 18 new members this Fall, compared to 8 new members the previous Fall.
- The 11 IFC fraternities welcomed 210 new members this Fall. This number is a **10.95% increase** from the Fall 2022 semester with 187 new members joining all 13 chapters.
- The 10 Panhellenic sororities welcomed 212 new members this Fall. This number is a **19.33% increase** from the Fall 2022 semester with 171 new members joining all 10 chapters.

Service & Philanthropy

- During the Fall 2023 semester, 5,435.81 hours of hands-on community service hours were completed by fraternity and sorority members. This number is a **19.03% increase** from the 4,401.19 hours performed in the Fall 2022 semester.
- During the Fall 2023 semester, \$107,561.20 was raised for charities by fraternities and sororities. This is a **48.53% increase** from \$55,359.58 during the Fall 2022 semester.
- The Greek community also donated non-perishable items such as canned goods and hygiene products to several local charities.
