POSITION DESCRIPTION & QUALIFICATIONS We seek an experienced healthcare educator and leader to design, deliver and evaluate interprofessional education and practice activities. IPEP is an overarching educational philosophy for College of Health undergraduate and graduate students that guides programming across academic units and in collaboration with regional healthcare, social service and educational entities. The Director will collaborate with academic unit heads and other college leadership, including the Director of Interdisciplinary Clinical Operations for the Interprofessional Community Clinic and Director of the Simulation and Skills Labs to develop engaging and interactive inperson, virtual, and asynchronous learning activities. The Director will also oversee the Healthy Lifestyle Center, which is emblematic of interprofessional education and practice through its interdisciplinary training of students to deliver prevention and community health services.

Candidates should hold an accredited terminal master's or doctoral degree (depending on discipline) in a healthcare or social service field, have at least 3 years of clinical/field practice in health or social services, and be eligible for an Indiana credential/license in their profession. Candidates with experience in higher education in IPEP or teaching are preferred.

Select responsibilities may include:

- Developing, delivering, and evaluating IPEP educational modules
- Convening and overseeing an advisory strategic planning committee
- Representing the College and University at internal and external events
- Providing leadership across academic programs as a member of the College leadership team
- Collaborating with regional colleges/universities and agencies on lifelong learning
- Seeking funding for IPEP programs
- Directing the Healthy Lifestyle Center

We seek candidates who will excite and motivate students of diverse backgrounds and contribute to a campus climate that supports equity, diversity, and inclusion.
