- A description in no more than 300 words of goals and aspirations for your college years and the years immediately thereafter.
- A statement in no more than 300 words through which you tell something about yourself that you think is important for us to know.

Applications should be completed and returned to: Honors College, Ball State University, 2000 W. University Ave., Muncie IN 47306 no later than **January 7, 2019**. Awards are made in March and are contingent on funds available. Applicants must have applied and been admitted to the Honors College to receive an award.
