Landscape Architectural Accreditation Board (LAAB) Policy for Accredited Programs to Use in Providing Information to the Public:

LAAB accredited programs are required to provide reliable information to the public. Programs must report on accreditation status and its performance. This information is to help potential students make informed application decisions.

#### **ACCREDITATION**

The Ball State University Bachelors of Landscape Architecture (BLA) and the Masters of Landscape Architecture (MLA) are nationally accredited degree programs by the LAAB.
