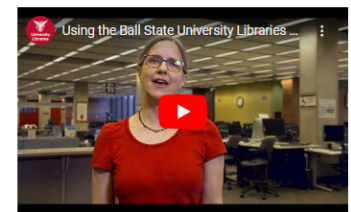
### LIBRARY TIPS FOR ACADEMIC SUCCESS WITH LESS STRESS
