Statistics for Jay County

28.8% of adults smoke in Jay County (Haines, 2020) Births and Deaths in 2019

- 46 births are affected by smoking (Haines, 2020)
- Percent of pregnant women who smoke:
- o Indiana: 11.5% (Haines, 2020)
- o Jay County: 13.4% (Haines, 2020)
- 63.3/100,000 residents have lung cancer-related deaths (Haines, 2020)
- Deaths attributable to smoking: 36 (Haines, 2020)
- Deaths due to secondhand smoke: 4 (Haines, 2020)
- Smoking related illnesses: 1,066 (Haines, 2020)

Costs in 2019

- Cost of smoking related births: \$62,468 (Haines, 2020)
- \$6.1 billion economic cost in Indiana due to smoking (Haines, 2020)
- \$903 per Indiana household state and federal tax burden from smoking-caused government expenditures (Haines, 2020)



Truth Initiative

- As of November 5, 2019, more than 2,000 vaping-related illnesses and 39 deaths have been reported to the CDC.
- Youth should not be exposed to nicotine because it can...
 - change brain chemistry to create a stronger addiction
 lead to memory and concentration problems
 - o make youth more susceptible to other addictive substances
- By 2016, nearly 4 out of 5 middle and high school students, or more than 20 million youth, saw at least one e-cigarette advertisement. 1

Jay County High School Presentation

- Freshman through Senior classes
- The presentation explained:
 - o Information concerning e-cigarettes
 - o Information about what vaping is and is not
 - The danger of vaping


Point of Sale Audit

- Over 20 stores were audited in Pennville, Redkey, Bryant, Albany, Dunkirk, and Portland
- Assessed advertising placement for tobacco products
- Determined if menthol cigarettes were sold there

Housing Surveys

Purpose: To determine current smoking trends in Jay County apartments

- 8 properties surveyed
- Included 68 buildings and 351 units
- Average of 9 buildings and 44 units per property
- 2 properties prohibited smoking
- Among properties that allow smoking, smoking is typically allowed outdoors as opposed to indoors
- 100% of properties that allow smoking were asked if they would <u>like</u> a smoke-free policy and they responded "Not a decision I can make"
