This scholarship is designed to be used to reimburse students for expenses incurred in the presentation of research or other scholarly work at a regional or national conferences (i.e., American Psychological Association, National Association of School Psychologists, Indiana Psychological Association, etc.) including reimbursement of conference registration, hotel, travel, per diem, and miscellaneous expenses. One scholarship per student per academic year. Preference will be given to students who are the lead authors on the conference presentation.

- An accumulative GPA of a 3.0 or better on a scale of 4.0
- A completed application approved/signed by a faculty mentor
- Proof you were accepted to present at a conference
- If applicable, proof you applied for additional funding
