The Department of Homeland Security (DHS) and the Student Exchange Visitor Program (SEVP) requires each university to establish an estimated cost of attendance for the first academic year (9 months).

Subtract any financial support or scholarship you are getting from the “Total Estimated Cost of Attendance” to determine the amount that you must present for the purpose of the visa interview. This amount will also be listed on your I-20 document. You must present evidence for this amount in the form of a bank statement and complete the Declaration of Financial Support (if the bank account presented is owned by someone else). You must also present evidence of any scholarship or other financial support you are receiving.

The **Undergraduate** “Total Cost of Attendance” was compiled based on double occupancy in [student housing with a standard 14 meals/week meal plan](#). The cost for the mandatory student [health insurance](#), [tuition and fees](#) are published on the BSU website. The cost for personal expenses, books, and supplies is an estimate and will vary for each student.

The **Graduate and Intensive English Institute (IEI) Only** “Total Cost of Attendance” was compiled based on estimated living expenses for an individual using the [MIT living wage calculator](#). The cost for the mandatory student [health insurance](#), [tuition and fees](#) are published on the BSU website. The cost for personal expenses, books, and supplies is an estimate and will vary for each student. Graduate tuition is the base amount for Main Campus programs. It does not include program fees for the MBA, CAP, etc.

The Total Cost of Attendance listed is only an estimate and is determined to be a reasonable estimate of the average cost of living for an individual for 9 months (a traditional academic year) in the greater Muncie, Indiana region. This estimated Total Cost of Attendance is subject to change without notice.
