Priority will be given to students who have demonstrated, through papers and projects in their sociology courses, sound sociological ideas about the causes of social behavior. For a future or current student majoring in English Education or Language Arts Teaching. Must demonstrate experience or commitment to teaching as evidenced by the application essay and/or extracurricular activities, demonstrate writing proficiency, and hold a cumulative GPA of at least 3.25 with a GPA of 3.5 or better in English courses. Renewable for up to 3 years.

Matt Jones Creative Writing Scholarship

- Awarded annually (when funding is available) to a BSU student majoring in English/Creative Writing who exhibits both a dedicated interest in creative writing and a demonstrated financial need.

Excellence in Creative Writing Scholarship

 Awarded annually (when funding is available) in recognition of artistic excellence in creative writing in poetry, fiction, creative nonfiction, and/or screenwriting by an undergraduate English Major or English Minor/Dual Minor at Ball State. Students are invited to apply in no more than two genres per application cycle, and may not reapply for any genre they have previously won an award in.
