CREDIT HOURS

Deakin University utilizes a credit point system. Most units have a weight of 1 credit point. One Deakin University credit point is equivalent to 4 BSU credits. Ball State exchange students are required to enroll in a minimum of 3 credit points (3 units) during each term of their exchange abroad. To maintain progress toward graduation we strongly recommend students take 4 units each term. For courses worth more than the approved BSU equivalent, excess credit will be articulated as INSA 400 unless otherwise designated by the academic department(s) on the Request for Study Abroad Credit form.
