



CREDIT HOUR & GRADING CONVERSION FOR
CHARLES UNIVERSITY IN PRAGUE
(CZECH REPUBLIC)

These guidelines have been developed based on information provided by the partner institutions and by professional credential evaluation organizations. Any questions about grade or credit equivalency should be addressed to the Study Abroad Office.

CREDIT HOURS

Summer: Charles University courses meet for 52 hours per 4-week term (summer) and are recommended for 3 credits each. During the summer, students take 1-3 courses, for 3-9 credits.

Semester: A mandatory Czech Language & Culture course is taught during orientation. It is a combination of Czech language instruction, cultural activities, and excursions throughout Prague. Classes are held for 4.5 hours per day, 5 days a week during the first 2 weeks of the program and recommended for 3 credits. Ball State students must take this course for a grade (no pass/fail) if they wish to have the course transfer back for credit. If taken pass/fail, the course will not transfer back to BSU. Fall and Spring Charles University courses meet for 45-52 hours per 12 or 13 week semester and are recommended for 3 credits each. Students take a minimum of 4, or maximum of 5, courses during the semester.
