CREDIT HOURS

Students enrolled in fall or spring are required to enroll in a minimum of 12 credit hours during their time abroad. Language levels are determined by placement test. Summer students enroll in between 3 and 9 credits, depending on program track and weeks of study. For individual courses worth more than the approved BSU equivalent, excess credit will be articulated as INSA 400 unless otherwise designated by the academic department(s) on the Request for Study Abroad Credit form.

Students must earn the Ball State equivalent of a C or better (10) in order to transfer a course from Cours de Civilisation Française de la Sorbonne (CCFS). The Ball State University transcript will reflect grades of CR or NC, which are not calculated into the student's cumulative grade point average.
