



CREDIT HOUR & GRADING CONVERSION FOR

UNIVERSITY OF WOLLONGONG (AUSTRALIA)

These guidelines have been developed based on information provided by the partner institutions and by professional credential evaluation organizations. Any questions about grade or credit equivalency

CREDIT HOURS

University of Wollongong (UOW) utilizes a credit point system. Most subjects have a weight of 6 credit points. Six UOW credit points are worth 4 BSU credits. Ball State students are required to enroll in a minimum of 18 credit points during each term of their exchange abroad. To maintain progress toward graduation we strongly recommend students consider 4 subjects (24 credit points) each term. For courses worth more than the approved BSU equivalent, excess credit will be articulated as INSA 400 unless otherwise designated by the academic department(s) on the Request for Study Abroad Credit form.

GRADE CONVERSION

Wollongong Scale	Ball State Equivalent
High Distinction (85-100%)	A
Distinction (75-84%)	A
Credit (65-74%)	B
Pass (50-64%)	C
Fail (below 50%)	F
Technical Fail	F

Students must earn the Ball State equivalent of a C or better (50%/Pass) in order to transfer a subject from Wollongong. The Ball State University transcript will reflect grades of CR or NC, which are not calculated into the student's cumulative grade point average.
