



CREDIT HOUR & GRADING CONVERSION FOR

Pontificia Universidad Catolica de Valparaiso (CHILE)

These guidelines have been developed based on information provided by the partner institutions and by professional credential evaluation organizations. Any questions about grade or credit equivalency should be addressed to the Study Abroad Office.

CREDIT HOURS

Students at the Pontificia Universidad Catolica de Valparaiso (Valparaiso) typically take 4-5 classes. The minimum course load is 12 BSU credits per semester (180 contact hours). Multiple courses at Valparaiso may be combined during articulation back to BSU course work. For individual courses worth more than the approved BSU equivalent, excess credit will be articulated as INSA 400 unless otherwise designated by the academic department(s) on the Request for Study Abroad Credit form.

Students must earn the Ball State equivalent of a 4 (C) or better to transfer a course from Valparaiso. The Ball State University transcript will reflect grades of CR or NC, which are not calculated into the student's cumulative grade point average.
