**CREDIT HOURS**

Worcester courses are called modules. Most modules at Worcester carry 15 UK credits, which are equal to 7.5 ECTS, or 3.75 BSU credits. BSU exchange students must enroll in 4 modules, for a total of 15 credits per semester. For individual courses worth more than the approved BSU equivalent, excess credit will be articulated as INSA 400 unless otherwise designated by the academic department(s) on the Request for Study Abroad Credit form.
