



## CREDIT HOUR & GRADING CONVERSION FOR

#### CREDIT HOURS

Students are required to enroll in a minimum of 12 BSU credits (180 hours) per semester. A typical course load abroad is 30 ECTS per term. For individual courses worth more than the approved BSU equivalent, excess credit will be articulated as INSA 400 unless otherwise designated by the academic department(s) on the Request for Study Abroad Credit form. Multiple Savoie courses may be combined when articulated back to BSU equivalents.
