CREDIT HOURS

Courses at Humboldt carry various credit weights, which are recorded as ECTS Credits. ECTS credits are worth twice the value of Ball State credits. For individual courses worth more than the approved BSU equivalent, excess credit will be articulated as INSA 400 unless otherwise designated by the academic department(s) on the Request for Study Abroad Credit form.
