CREDIT HOURS

Semester Limerick students are required to take five courses, valued at 6 ECTS each, for a total of 15 credits. For individual courses worth more than the approved BSU equivalent, excess credit will be articulated as INSA 400 unless otherwise designated by the academic department(s) on the Request for Study Abroad Credit form.
