



**CREDIT HOUR & GRADING CONVERSION FOR**

These guidelines have been developed based on information provided by the partner institutions and by professional credential evaluation organizations. Any questions about grade or credit equivalency should be addressed to the Study Abroad Office.

**CREDIT HOURS**

Aichi University of Education (AUE) courses carry 30 contact hours and are typically worth 2 BSU credits. Students take a minimum of 12 BSU credits (180 hours) each term while abroad. For AUE courses worth less than 3 BSU credits, multiple AUE courses may be combined on the RSAC form to equal a single BSU course. For courses at AUE worth more than 3 BSU credits, excess credit will be articulated as INSA 400 unless otherwise designated by the academic department(s) on the Request for Study Abroad Credit form.

**GRADE CONVERSION**

<b>AUE Grade</b>	<b>Ball State Equivalent</b>
S (100-90)	A
A (89-80)	A
B (79-70)	B
C (69-60)	C
F (0-59)	F

Students must earn the Ball State equivalent of a C or better (60) in order to transfer a course from AUE. The Ball State University transcript will reflect grades of CR or NC, which are not calculated into the student's cumulative grade point average.
