CREDIT HOURS

Sapporo courses carry the same credit hour weight as Ball State courses. Each course is typically worth 2 or 4 credits. Students take a minimum of 12 BSU credits while abroad. For Sapporo courses worth less than 3 credits, multiple Sapporo courses may be combined on the RSAC form to equal a single BSU course. For courses at Sapporo worth more than 3 credits, excess credit will be articulated as INSA 400 unless otherwise designated by the academic department(s) on the Request for Study Abroad Credit form.
