

CREDIT HOUR & GRADING CONVERSION FOR

CREDIT HOURS

Tokyo Gakugei University (TGU) courses carry 30 contact hours and is typically worth 2 BSU credits. Students take a minimum of 12 BSU credits (180 hours) each term while abroad. For TGU courses worth less than 3 BSU credits, multiple TGU courses may be combined on the RSAC form to equal a single BSU course. For courses at TGU worth more than 3 BSU credits, excess credit will be articulated as INSA 400 unless otherwise designated by the academic department(s) on the Request for Study Abroad Credit form.

Students must earn the Ball State equivalent of a C or better (60) in order to transfer a course from TGU. The Ball State University transcript will reflect grades of CR or NC, which are not calculated into the student's cumulative grade point average.
